The exhibitions feature hundreds of artefacts, films and photos from our archives.

A HISTORIC MONUMENT FULL OF EMOTIONS

Located on a former coal mine, the Centre Historique Minier is today the largest mining museum in France and a major cultural site attracting tourists to Hauts-de-France. It bears witness to an exciting industrial and human adventure. Since 2012, it has also been recognised as a remarkable site of the Nord-Pas-de-Calais mining basin, which is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Wander through the authentic buildings of the Delloye colliery to understand how a coal mine is operated.
