THE DELLOYE PIT, HISTORICAL MONUMENT

Located on a former coal-mining pit, the Historical Mining Centre is now a major tourist and cultural site in the Hauts-de-France region, bearing witness to an exciting human and industrial adventure. It has been recognised as a remarkable site within the Mining Basin, listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

In the original Delloye pit buildings, clothes hanging in the bathroom, hundreds of authentic lamps and the imposing coils of the mining machine all come together to immerse you in the world of the mine.



THE MINE IN BROAD DAYLIGHT

Explore all aspects of the mine in the exhibits: touch the coal, travel back through 270 years of mining history, share in the daily life of the miner, enter the stable to understand the role of horses and test your knowledge about energy...



JOURNEY TO THE HEART OF THE MINE

Accompanied by a cultural guide, descend into the depths of the galleries to enter the coal-mining sites. A tour punctuated by the roar of machines and screenings of archival films showing miners at work.
